

Course: Introduction to BusPlanner

Duration: 2 days

Overview

This course is designed to give new users the skills and knowledge required to work within the BusPlanner environment. In the course exercises, you will perform query functions to locate pertinent data such as, students, bus stops, runs and routes. Users will learn proper techniques such as addition of new objects like stops and students as well as proper run and route construction and maintenance.

Goals

- Understand the basic tools and terminology that make up BusPlanner
- Understand and use query tools to locate a specific object
- Edit features within BusPlanner
- Understand route planning methodologies
- Manipulate and display results on screen

Audience

This course is designed for users that are new to BusPlanner and that require a working knowledge of how to use the program.

Prerequisites and recommendations

Introduction to BusPlanner is recommended for all users of BusPlanner and ideally should be the first course taken.
